



THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2012

The Ruth Prowse School of Art is committed to being an art centre for the whole community; an extensive scholarship program is in place. It is the mission of the school to redress the educational imbalances of the past by nurturing young talent for the future who do not have the resources.

The financial support provides for full, substantive and partial tuition fees for the full duration of three-year program to deserving students of academic merit in financial need and for deserving students from historically disadvantaged communities.

Annual renewal of the full scholarship is solely dependent on an aggregate class attendance of 80 % and an average marks percentage of above 60% and the applicants are interviewed by the Scholarship Committee from the Board of Directors.

As the School is a non-governmental body that receives no educational subsidies from the South African Dep. of Education, the number of students that have the opportunity to access the scholarship fund is dependent on the generosity of our donors.

Application forms are available from the School. Applicants need to submit by the 30th September annually pre-ceding the year of proposed study.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
2. The Scholarship grant is awarded in three tranches. The tranches are credited to the fee account. The student must achieve an aggregate class attendance of 80 % and an average marks percentage of above 60%.
3. A tranche will not be awarded if the criteria is not met and the fee account will not be credited and the student guardian will then be liable for the fees.
4. Please note that the Scholarship Committee considers that 50% of the scholarship award will be considered as a loan until the successful graduation of your particular year of study.
5. Should your studies be unsuccessful or you discontinue your studies this amount will be payable to the School within three months at no interest.
